

BLACK-HOLE REPLACED BY A "MAGIC WAND" OF CREATION OF THE UNIVERSE

Galaxies are island universes made of many billions to trillions of stars whirling through clouds of gases filling these islands. There are many billions of such island universes outside our own, which is known as the Milky Way galaxy. Our sun has its home in the outskirts of this Milky Way island far away from its centre.
